Your Countdown to Medicare Checklist





This simple checklist will help you prepare for Medicare.

6-12 months before you turn 65

- If applicable, meet with your HR department at your current (or former) job. Ask about retiree benefits and how to claim them.
- Write down what your monthly income will be after your retire. Then make a list of current expenses. Keep in mind that your medical expenses may increase over time.
- Meet with a financial advisor to go over your pension or 401(k) plan and create an income distribution plan.

4-5 months before you turn 65

- Learn more about Medicare and Medicare prescription drug plans: what they cost, what they cover, how and when to enroll.
- Call Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Alabama to learn more about our Medicare Advantage, Medicare Supplement and Prescription Drug plans. Find a plan that fits your needs and budget.
- Review your Social Security statement to make sure all your information is correct. Confirm your eligibility for Medicare benefits by contacting the Social Security Administration at www.socialsecurity.gov or 1-800-772-1213 (TTY: 1-800-325-0778).

0-3 months before you turn 65

- Enroll in Medicare Part A & Part B by contacting the Social Security Administration at www.socialsecurity.gov or 1-800-772-1213 (TTY: 1-800-325-0778).
- Enroll in a Blue Advantage® (PPO) Medicare Advantage plan, OR a C PlusSM Medicare Supplement plan with a BlueRxSM (PDP) Prescription Drug plan.
- Make sure you've received your Medicare card. After enrolling in a plan, make sure you receive your health and/or drug plan card.
